

Mr. Craig Englert, assistant superintendent of business services, explained that the budget amendment is necessitated by the Performing Arts Center construction and the related bond issue; additional special education transportation; additional grant funds allocated to the District; and changes in property tax allocations necessitated by a new law. Mr. Englert explained that the amended budget also will cover the expense of out-of-District student services, McKinney-Vento transportation, and a new HVAC system at Sauk School. Mr. Englert estimates a \$150,000–\$350,000 budget surplus.

Mr. Bean invited public comment on the matter; hearing none, he closed the hearing.
