

Student Access to Pearson Products

Just a few easy steps . . .


1. Log into your District 162 Google account. The username is your Student ID Number followed by @sd162.org (example: 123456@sd162.org). The default password is your Student ID Number followed by 'google' in all lowercase letters (example: 123456google).






2. From your Drive Desktop (not the Search screen), click on the "waffle menu" in the upper right corner. Scroll to the bottom, then click More, then locate and click the Pearson Easybridge icon.

3. A new tab will open to Pearson EasyBridge. On the left side, notice your courses (Science, Social Studies, & Math (grades 6-8 only). On the right are several links. The digital Student Editions of each subject live here. However, if you click Realize, then you can access all of them, along with assignments and more.

4. Many students will need to follow 3 quick steps to setup their login choices (language, background image, and profile image). Once this is done, you will be at your Pearson products Dashboard.



The Dashboard for grades K-2 may look a little different & more kid-friendly.

- 5. Now you are at the Pearson Dashboard:
 - On the left side in green are all programs you have access to for your grade level.
 - In the middle in red are the classes the student has along with current assignments from the teacher(s).
 - On the right side in blue will be current grades or assessment results.
